Summer Study Tour to London, England

We are writing to gauge the interest of parents in a study tour to London, England.

Please note that we are **only** at the initial planning stage and there may be some changes in cost and dates depending on flight confirmation, hotel bookings and the exchange rate. You will need to pay about HK\$22,000 which covers the flight, travel insurance, chaperone expenses, hotel accommodation, theatre and attraction tickets, transportation in London, and course fees and excursions with Wymondham College,
