Summer Study Tour to London, England

The English Department of our school can now confirm our trip to London, England from 14th July to 2nd August, 2010 as one of the 'other learning experiences' for your child. This study tour not only provides your child the opportunity to learn about a new country and develop his/her language skills but it also helps your child to become more independent and take the responsibility for his/her learning.

The cost of the trip is \$22,000 and this includes the flight, travel insurance, chaperone expenses, hotel accommodation, theatre and attraction tickets, transportation in London, and course fees and excursions with Wymondham College (www.wymondhamcollege.org).
