S.6 English Language Excursion to 1881 Heritage

As part of the English curriculum and experiential programme, and to give students an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the city that we live in, S6 students will be visiting 1881 Heritage to learn about the historical significance of the location on Friday, 9th November, 2018. We will also complete a challenge in English with some tourists.

To help further enhance your child's English language learning experience from this visit and promote Hong Kong to an international audience, encouraging them to visit our city, students will be required to produce a video after the visit.

The project will require students to introduce the heritage spots and interact with tourists of different nationalities. As students are required to be working in groups around the Harbourfront, no teacher will be accompanying them during that period. The teachers will be stationed in 1881 Heritage and would have contact with the group leaders through whatsapp.
