**S4 English Excursion to Green Hub (4L and 4P)**

To provide students with opportunities to use English in meaningful contexts outside the classroom, the English Department has arranged an excursion to Green Hub for Secondary 4 students.

Green Hub is the revitalisation of the Old Tai Po Police Station, which is a Grade 1 historic building built in 1899. It was recognised with an Honourable Mention in the 2016 UNESCO Asia-Pacific Awards for Cultural Heritage Conservation.

In this excursion, not only will students be taken on a heritage tour of the Old Tai Po Police Station, they will also take part in the Eat Well Workshop which integrates the STEM education modules into food education. A range of hands-on activities such as gardening, food preparation, and waste recycling will be covered in the programme.

Other than activities on the day of the excursion, students are expected to do research before the visit and, in groups, produce a written product or video after the visit.
