5J and 5M Local Excursion Project

As part of the English curriculum and experiential programme, we are going to go on a field trip to Tsim Sha Tsui, Hong Kong on Monday, 8th April 2019.

To give students an opportunity to develop a greater understanding of the city that we live in, S.5 students will be visiting different areas of Tsim Sha Tsui with the aim of learning about the locations and promoting them to an international audience, encouraging them to visit our city. To help further enhance your child's English language learning experience from this visit, a group project related to the visit will need to be completed.

The project will require students to complete a challenge in English with some tourists in Tsim Sha Tsui, and introduce Hong Kong's culture to foreigners according to the proposal presented in their English class. As students are divided up in groups, and their projects will require them to move around the Tsim Sha Tsui district, no teacher will be accompanying them to each of the spots. The teachers will be stationed in 1881 Heritage and would have whatsapp contact with the group leaders.

12 noon – 3:50 p.m.	- Arrival to 1881 Heritage <i>*(students can buy their lunch in the area or carry a packed lunch).</i> - Completion of the designed challenge. - Introduction of a significant Heritage spot at 1881 Heritage and/or Tsim Sha Tsui
4:00 p.m.	Debriefing and dismissal at 1881 Heritage
