### Scholarship Opportunities at STC

- ✧ At STC, we have different types of scholarships to support you in achieving your goals. This section provides a general overview of each scholarship category. The scholarships are mostly *Merit-Based scholarships* which are for students who demonstrate excellence or have consistently performed at a standard significantly above their peers in academics, arts, athletics, service, leadership or other areas. These Merit-Based scholarships are also called '*Recommended awards*'.

### Special thanks

- ✧ Thanks to the generosity of external donors, in particularly our devoted alumni, and past Principals, STC is able to offer many awards to our students. We at STC base our recommendations for scholarships on a range of factors, such as academic achievement, leadership, STC involvement, and participation in athletic teams.

### Types of awards

#### I. Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded at the end of the academic year for academic achievement. They are based on grades and achievements. They can also include non-academic factors such as leadership, STC involvement, and other criteria.

#### II. Academic awards

Academic awards are given out at the end of the academic year and are based on academic achievement.

#### III. Non-academic or service awards

Non-academic or service awards recognize achievement or participation in athletics, leadership, STC or community involvement and other rewarding pursuits.

#### IV. Bursary

Granted to students who do academically well and are in need financially.

<p><b>Mrs. L. M. Li Memorial Scholarship</b> 李文麗妹紀念獎學金</p>	<p>S.6</p>	<p>This is awarded to students scoring the top two marks in the school's Mock Examination in the subject of Chinese History.</p>																
<p><b>Mr. Edward Li Scholarship</b> 李生校友獎學金</p>	<p>S.6</p>	<p>This is awarded to students scoring the top two marks in the school's Mock Examination in the subject of Geography.</p>																

<b>Academic Awards</b>	S.1 to S.6	This is awarded to students who rank first in each subject in their form in the school Final Examination/Mock Examinations.
<b>Cultural Awards</b>	S.1 to S.6	<p>This is awarded to the student in each form who excels in the subject of Physical Education. The awardees are nominated by the PE Department.</p> <p>This is awarded to S.1 to S.3 students. The award is presented to the student who excels in each form in Visual Arts, Music, Technology and Living, Computer Literacy and Ethics &amp; Religious Education. The awardees are nominated by the respective departments.</p>
<b>Mr. Malcolm Long Scholarship</b>	S.1 to S.3	This is awarded to students for their excellence in performance in the school examination in each class. This is based on the top three positions in the class.
<b>Mr. Edward Wong Scholarship</b>	S.4 to S.5	<p>This is awarded to students for their excellence in performance in the school examination in each class. This is based on the top three positions in the class.</p> <p>The position in class is determined by averaging the marks of the four core subjects; and one best elective subject. The awardees must also attain at least 'A-' in conduct.</p>
<b>Ms. Hilda Kwan Scholarship (Core Subjects Improvement Awards)</b>	S.1 to S.5	<p>This is awarded to students who have made academic improvement in the core subjects. It is determined by comparing the marks of the Interim Examination with the Final examination. It is awarded to the 5 students with the most improvement.</p> <p>The awardees must also attain at least 'B+' in conduct.</p>
<b>Mr. Joseph Kung Scholarship</b>	S.1 to S.5	This is awarded to students who have made academic improvement in Chinese Language. It is determined by comparing the marks of the Interim Examination with the Final examination. It is awarded to the 2 students with the most improvement.
<b>Mr. Tai Kwan Scholarship</b>	S.1 to S.5	This is awarded to students who have made academic improvement in English Language. It is determined by comparing the marks of the Interim Examination with the Final examination. It is awarded to the 2 students with the most improvement.
<b>Most Academically Improved Awards</b>	Award to S.1 to S.5 students	<p>This is awarded to students who have made significant academic improvement in each form. It is determined by comparing the marks of the Interim Examination with the Final examination. It is awarded to the 5 students with the most improvement.</p> <p>To be eligible for this award, the awardee must gain at least a 5 mark increase in their GPA. The awardees must also attain at least 'B+' in conduct.</p>

<p><b>Mrs. Mary Poon Scholarship (Junior All-rounders Awards)</b></p>	<p>S.1 to S.3</p>	<p>This is awarded to the student who excels in Physical Education, Visual Arts, Music, Computer Literacy, Technology &amp; Living (S.1 to S.2), Ethics &amp; Religious Education, Putonghua &amp; Business Foundation. It is awarded to the 5 top students in each form. The awardees are nominated by each respective department.</p> <p>To be eligible for this award, the awardee must have an academic rank within the first 40 positions in the form. The awardees must also attain at least ‘A-’ in conduct.</p>
<p><b>Leadership Awards</b></p>		<p>This is a leadership award. Head Prefects, Deputy Head Prefects, Chairpersons and Executive Members of the Student Union, Chairpersons of Clubs and House Captains are eligible for this award. The awardees are to be nominated by the Student Activities Committee.</p> <p>To be eligible for this award, the awardee must have an academic rank within the first 80 in the form. The awardees must also attain at least ‘B+’ in conduct.</p>
<p><b>Character Excellence and Service Awards</b></p>	<p>S.1 to S.6 students</p>	<p>This is awarded to the student who displays outstanding character. The awardee from each class is selected by their class-teachers and teachers, based on the following criteria: strength of character, integrity, commitment, teamwork and class leadership.</p> <p>To be eligible for this award, the awardees must also attain at least ‘A-’ in conduct.</p>
<p><b>Best Athletes Awards</b></p>	<p>S.1 to S.6 students</p>	<p>This is awarded to top athletes. One award will be presented each for Girls Grade A, Boys Grade A; Girls Grade B, Boys Grade B; and Girls Grade C, Boys Grade C.</p> <p>The awardees are to be nominated by the Physical Education Department.</p>
