First Interview: 1st March 2025 (Saturday)
(All applicants will be interviewed. No make-up interview will be arranged.)

Second Interview: 15th March 2025 (Saturday)
(Applicants selected to join the second interview will be notified individually.)

Application Procedure

1. Application Forms can be obtained in person from the College's General Office during office hours or downloaded from the College's website (<https://www.stc.edu.hk>).
2. Applications can be submitted in person during office hours. Applications by mail will not be accepted. Parents or guardians who cannot submit an application in person can choose to make use of the SSPA e-Platform managed by the Education Bureau. Please submit AT MOST THREE supporting documents. A recommendation letter from the Head of the Primary School is also NOT required.
 - *Certificate of Baptism (if applicable, at your discretion)*
 - (v) *A self-addressed stamped envelope with sufficient postage*
4. Applicants must attend an interview at the time allocated by the College. The date is 1st March 2025 (Saturday). Applicants will be notified by email the allocated interview time in due course.

All personal information collected will solely be used for the College's Secondary One admission purposes. All data will be destroyed upon completion of the entire Secondary One admission process.
